

California new light vehicle market declined 5.3 percent during the first three months of this year, while the U.S. market fell 2.9 percent.

Light truck registrations in the state slipped one percent, while passenger cars fell 10.3 percent.

Passenger car market share in California was 43.9 percent vs. 30.1 percent in the Nation.

**California Quarterly New Light Vehicle Registrations** 








The California new vehicle market recorded its eighth consecutive year-over-year decline in the First Quarter of 2019.


### Non Luxury SUV Market Share in California Increases to 30 Percent in 2019











Percent Change in New Retail Registrations - YTD '19 vs. YTD '18

Comparison of California New and Used Vehicle Markets -Percent change in registrations (YTD '19 thru March vs. YTD '18)










