

State New Vehicle Market Predicted to Remain Strong in 2020



New vehicle registrations in California are expected to slip to 1.82 million units in 2020.

The state's new vehicle market is predicted to decline 3.7 percent from 2019 to 2020, a smaller decline than the 5.5 percent drop in 2019.

Although the market is shifting lower, new vehicle registrations this year should exceed the 2009 total by more than 780,000 units.

California new light vehicle market declined 5.5 percent from 2018 to 2019, while the U.S. market fell 1.1 percent.

Light truck registrations in the state were essentially unchanged, while passenger cars fell 12.2 percent.

Light truck market share in California was 58.4 percent in 2019 vs. 71.9 percent in the Nation.

California Quarterly New Light Vehicle Registrations Percent Change vs. Year Earlier







New vehicle registrations in the state fell 7.0 percent in 4Q '19 vs. the 3.8% drop in the Third Quarter.


Non Luxury SUV Market Share in California Reached 31% in 2019





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

Retail Passenger Car Registrations Declined by 33 Percent Between 2015 and 2019




California New Car and Light Truck Retail and Fleet Registrations - 2012 thru 2019, Annual Totals





Percent Change in New Retail Registrations - 2019 vs. 2018




ANALYSIS OF USED VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS BY VEHICLE AGE



Civic Had Big Lead in California Used Vehicle Market in 2019; RAV4 Had Largest Percentage Gain


