The California New Car Dealers Association (CNCDA) <u>"CAR CAREERS" Scholarship Program</u> is an annual scholarship opportunity through the CNCDA Scholarship Foundation. The scholarship supports the future automotive workforce by offering twenty awards to highly skilled and motivated California college students pursuing a career in auto technology. The top twenty scholarship awardees will receive \$5,000 each, and one statewide recipient will receive an additional \$5,000.

Applicants must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the award:

- Be a resident of California.
- Be a high school senior or graduate, or current college student.
- Pursuing an Automotive Technology degree.
- Enrolled or plan on enrolling in study at an accredited college or vocational technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.
- Maintain at least a part-time status of 6 units each term.
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent).

The scholarship application must be submitted by June 15, 2021.

The reimagined scholarship program seeks to provide geographic equity by offering four scholarship awardees \$5,000 in each of the five CNCDA regions, totaling \$20,000 per region and one statewide recipient who will receive an additional \$5,000.

- Fuel a 21st Century workforce to support the industry's demands. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, an estimated 46,000 automotive service technicians and mechanics will be needed to fill roles through 2026.
- Accelerate the "grease to geek evolution" of the Auto Technician profession. Foster the dynamic technology and mechanical skills needed to repair today's complex vehicles, further supporting California's environmental goals to transition to a cleaner electric vehicle future.
